- **Homelessness** - Pray specifically for the development of a Transitional Housing center in the city.
 - We are seeing more older people and families living in cars from being priced out of their rental situations, illnesses of breadwinner, family challenges ...
 - Bigger Picture Homeless Issues to pray for breakthrough in:
 - Expanded Housing options - Specifically the “Costa Mesa Living Facility” that our team is working to develop – that God would provide the right location.
 - For The Community Impact Team to establish more structure and clarity and be able to reach more of the younger, resistant group on the streets.
 - Coordination with the County and cooperation between cities
 - The Count on Jan 23 -24
 - The education of the public on homelessness.
 - Coordination & Cooperation between service providers
 - Pray that those on the street with Mental Health issues and Addiction issues that are resistant to open their hearts and minds to receive some help & care.
 - Pray for more Advocates, willing to engage with people, to step up from our churches.
 - Pray for current leaders within the Network of care:

 - Shawn Davidson with Saturday Life On The Streets – CORE Team development.

 - Pastor Phil Eyskens & Lindah Miles at Lighthouse Church of the Nazarene – Need some folks to be on the Inclement weather team to stay and pray on rainy nights.

 - Shannon Santos – at Someone Cares Soup Kitchen – Tough times on Budget issues.
